Principal Report- we currently have 64 students(42 elementary,22 high school), two left from grade 8 so no grade 8 class. In the school generated funds account we have \$2867.69. The grades 1-12 went to Love Land on Oct 24, the students enjoyed the day and learned lots. There was school assembly on Oct 31, and had activities for the students in the afternoon. Thank you to the SCC for the treat bags. The junior girls volleyball team went to NESSAC, all matches were close but unfortunately did not win NESSAC. The SRC put on a Remembrance Day service for students and community members job well done. We were to have a book fair but unfortunately we have had a delay in receiving the books, so may have to order online. On Nov 21, no school for students as teachers have a SIP day, the staff will be learning on professional development on restorative practices, this is to emphasize repairing the harm done to people and relationships, rather than punishing people. Our next school sport we have is basketball, NESD is looking into a 3 on 3 league as it could potentially be new sport in the SHSAA. They are looking into mixed league, versus just girls and boys team We currently have enough for a mixed junior team, but not enough interest for senior team. Mr. Smoke has been approached by a community member to help coach when curling starts. Mr. Smoke will discuss with last year coach to see about their plans for coaching this year. Our Assembly for November will be on Dec 2. We will be doing Christmas Food Drive from Dec 1-15. December 20, will be the Christmas School Concert. It has been decided not to do the store of giving with elementary students this year, but instead do a book gift exchange. The students will bring in a used or new book to exchange with classmates. The teachers will organize this with their own class.

Other Business: WE need more communication between staff/school and with parents on events happening example spirit week parents didn't have much of
