Principal report: We currently have 70 students 47 elementary and 23 high school In school generated account they have \$2867.69. Other Business:

The SCC will be doing a family pizza meal at noon on April 28, we will make up slips to go out next week, with the return on 24, but a reminder sent out on 21, two or three SCC members will go in and count up pizza slices etc, there will be four options to choose from. Easter Egg hunt will be on April 6, in afternoon the older students will buddy up with the kids in elementary, we will purchase cupcakes for older kids. Discussed communication between teacher and parents, how slips are not being sent home so parents know what is going on in the class or for SRC things.
