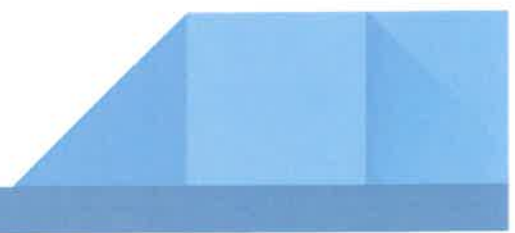

Lastly, please remember to send extra clothes with your child. March is a wet month and a change of clothes will likely be necessary at some point. Happy Spring Everyone!


