Hello Arborfield School Community,

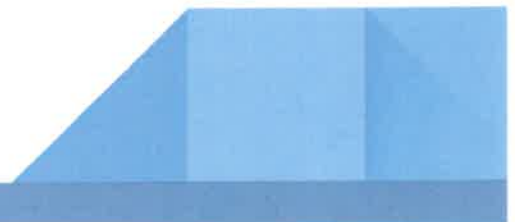


