The June 8, meeting with the feedback we got from public, the SCC should write a letter and send to Don Remple, Kevin Trew and Marla Walton in regards to what the community said. The graduation Patrick will see if there are some parents who took pictures that will post pictures on school page and he will post Track and Field pictures today on school page.
