3-Principals Report- NESD hasn't received the grant for water stations as of yet. Gift Certificates for the Wolves Leaders will be purchased March 1-5 and receipt will be given to Julie for reimbursement. Transportation hasn't given any more clarification on what will happen with Lenny Lindsays route. They are saying there is still a lack of qualified drivers and not sure if there will be a bus on a regular basis. Newsletters between teachers and families has been going really well and there has been a huge positive response with that. Tape a teacher to the wall will no longer take place as NESD feels it is unsafe, the staff and SRC will pool money together for a donation close to \$1300.00 going towards Telemiracle. Winter fest will not take place due to Covid rules, at the Staff meeting an elementary option will be questioned and will find out if the SCC can supply hot dogs and hot chocolate for the kids.

4-Financials- Julie \$2660.29 balance end of January 2021 with outstanding Mavis \$174.00 (cookies), Lina \$221.78 (shovels) and Julie (juice boxes) There should be \$2264.51 end of February (minus Julies total)

5-New Business

Patrick wondered if the SCC would be interested in helping out the Graduating class with supplying a rental for a tent for their Grad. He will look into this and get a quote into the SCC .

Kindergarten registration has been coming in higher than expected, there will possibly be 12-14 students instead of the 6-10 previously thought. If this is the case there will need to be a reevaluation with the K,1, 2 class as there will be over 23 students for 1 teacher. EA's are highly needed in the elementary end for added support.

Sliding will not be able to take place this year due to COVID 19 regulations, but Patrick will look into the possibility of cohort excursions.

Family literacy week in Arborfield, Patrick will look into different options at the next staff meeting and Scholastic Books to see if they sponsor events like this.
